



Referee Substitution Program

Purpose

- To provide refs to teams who:
 1. Cannot meet the minimum ref requirement
 2. Cannot provide full refs
 3. Choose to omit from some or all their reffing duties

Procedure

Refs

- Please register online at <http://www.saskdodgeball.com/> to be added to the pool
 - Refs are able to sign up at any time
 - Refs must notify events@saskdodgeball.com to be removed from the pool
- Refs will be notified (via emailed) a *minimum* of 48 hours in advance for available reffing shifts.
- Shifts will be assigned to individual refs from the pool on a first come first serve basis.
- Refs will have up to 24 hours prior to the shift to sign up.
- Refs will be paid \$15/shift
 - Payment will be issued to individual refs at the year end captains meeting.

Teams

- Teams must submit a request online at <http://www.decadodgeball.com/> a minimum of 48 hours prior to your reffing shifts. The earlier the notice, the better.
 - Teams are still required to open & close the gym if they are a keyholder
- Refs will have up to 24 hours prior to the shift to sign up.
- Please transfer \$15 (per ref that is required – include your team name) to treasurer@saskdodgeball.com once your ref(s) are confirmed.

Consequences

- If the ref bails out of their committed duties within 24 hours of their shift (and another ref cannot be provided), the ref will be fined \$20 as per the infraction section of the rules. The fine is required to be paid prior to registration in the following season.
- Refs deemed unfair, incompetent or not actively involved in the game will be removed from the pool.
- If funds are not transferred prior to the start of the game, teams will be fined \$15 per provided ref plus an additional \$20
- If refs from the pool are not available, teams will be notified 24 hours before their required reffing shift and they will be responsible for providing their own refs or risk fines as per the infraction section of the rules.
